

It's Snow Season, here's what you need to know:

You must clear your sidewalks of snow and ice within **24 hours** from the time the snow stops falling. Citations will be issued.

Do not shovel your snow into the street or gutter, use that snow in your yard whenever you can.

Avoid water billing estimates. Clear snow from your meter pit.

Snow Plowing is done by the Town's Public Works Department.

1st priority – Schools, High traffic streets for example; Washington, Jefferson, Sixth, Hwy. 1 etc.

2nd priority – Third, Kitfox, Buffalo Creek Parkway etc.

Residential streets, one pass will be done after all high traffic streets are cleared. Cleveland Avenue is plowed by Colorado Dept. of Transportation.

Those having issues registering online after 6 pm on Dec 16 can be added to the wait list.** Game and practice times TBD by availability of gym space. Note that games and practices will be held weeknights and **can go as late as 9 pm.**
-  **ADULT COED VOLLEYBALL** (age 14+). Team fee is \$310 for 8 games. Games played Friday nights at Wellington Middle School. League limited to 8 teams.
