NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION

(UNOFFICIAL)

A MUNICIPAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF WELLINGTON, COLORADO ON TUESDAY, APRIL 3, 2018, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SEVEN O'CLOCK A.M. (7:00 A.M.) AND SEVEN O'CLOCK P.M. (7:00 PM.) AT THE WILSON LEOPER CENTER, 3800 WILSON AVENUE, WELLINGTON, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION, YOU MUST HAVE ATTAINED EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE. BE A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES. HAVE RESIDED IN THE TOWN OF WELLINGTON FOR 30 DAYS. BE REGISTERED TO VOTE IN LARIMER COUNTY.

TOWN OFFICERS TO BE ELECTED ARE FOUR (4) TRUSTEES AND ONE (1) MAYOR. THE THREE CANDIDATES FOR TRUSTEE WITH THE HIGHEST VOTE TOTAL SHALL RECEIVE FOUR YEAR TERMS AND ONE CANDIDATE WILL HAVE A TWO-YEAR TERM.

NOMINATION PETITIONS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE TOWN HALL AT 3735 CLEVELAND AVE. WELLINGTON, COLORADO AS OF TUESDAY, JANUARY 2, 2018 THE LAST DAY NOMINATION PETITIONS FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION MAY BE FILED WITH THE TOWN CLERK IS 5 P.M., MONDAY JANUARY 22, 2018.

EACH REGISTERED ELECTOR SIGNING A NOMINATION PETITION MUST INCLUDE STREET ADDRESS ALONG WITH THEIR SIGNATURE. A REGISTERED ELECTOR MAY SIGN ONE (1) NOMINATION PETITION FOR EACH SEPARATE OFFICE TO BE FILLED. TO BECOME A CANDIDATE, AT LEAST TEN (10) REGISTERED ELECTORS MUST SIGN THE PETITION AND ADD HIS OR HER PLACE OF RESIDENCE.

NO WRITE-IN VOTE FOR ANY MUNICIPAL OFFICE SHALL BE COUNTED UNLESS AN AFFIDAVIT OF INTENT HAS BEEN FILED WITH THE CLERK BY THE PERSON WHOSE NAME IS WRITTEN IN BY 5:00 P.M. ON MONDAY JANUARY 29, 2018.

It's Snow Season, here's what you need to know:

You must clear your sidewalks of snow and ice within **24 hours** from the time the snow stops falling. Citations will be issued.

Do not shovel your snow into the street or gutter, use that snow in your yard whenever you can. **Avoid** water billing estimates. Clear snow from your meter pit. **Snow Plowing** is done by the Town's Public Works Department. **1st priority** – Schools, High traffic streets for example; Washington, Jefferson, Sixth, Hwy. 1 etc.

2nd priority – Third, Kitfox, Buffalo Creek Parkway etc. **Residential streets**, one pass will be done after all high traffic streets are cleared. Cleveland Avenue is plowed by Colorado Dept. of Transportation.

WOULD YOU LIKE TO LOWER YOUR SEWER RATE?

WINTER SEWER AVERAGES ARE STARTING

Now is the time to start conserving water to lower your sewer rate. The cost for water sent down the drain inside your home is calculated annually, usually based on the average amount of water your household uses during January, February, and March. These 3 winter months were chosen so customers would not be charged for treated water used outdoors. If we are forced by the elements (*snow*) to estimate water use during this time, we will do 4-month average which would include your December utility bill. All water used during this time, will be included in your sewer rate average. New sewer rates take effect on your May utility bill and that sewer rate will remain the same until the following April.
