 - A. Meeting Minutes of August 5, 2024

6. New Business

A. Site Development Plan and Preliminary Plat of Lot 7 and Lot 8, Wellington Business Center.

Cody Bird, Planning Director, gave an overview of the plan and presented the staff report. The plan entails four buildings, two on each lot, to be used for commercial purposes. The applicant meets all the findings for approval, and staff recommended approval of both lots in one motion.

The applicants Scoo Leary and Steve Wimp and their civil engineer Shane Ritchie spoke briefly, thanking staff and offering a few clarifying comments.

Chairman Sartor asked for any conflicts of interest or ex parte communications.

Commissioner Knaack noted that she had purchased a property from Mr. Leary years before, but that they had no present financial or transactional relationship. There were no ex parte communications.

Chairman Sartor opened the public hearing.

Chairman Sartor closed the public hearing.

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Whitehouse moved to approve the site development plan for Lot 7 and Lot 8, Wellington Business Center, and forward a recommendation to the Board of Trustees to approve the Preliminary Plat for Wellington Business Center, Amendment No. 1.
