- C. CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES
 - a. September 11th, 2024
 - i. Motion to Approve: Aaron McConnell
 - ii. Minutes Approved
- D. BOARD REVIEW AND DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS
 - a. Guest Speaker Alexis
 - i. Made trip to some of Wellington Parks, noting Winick and Viewpointe Parks as two areas that could fit with model of a community garden
 - ii. Maps and plots of the areas were designed for the two parks due to feasibility of site access, parking, accessibility and other amenities close to designated community garden's potential locations.
 - iii. Access to water was noted at Winick and discussed as potential for Viewpointe Park, with the goal to have the gardens in areas of unutilized passive turf and would help reduce water use for the park.
 - iv. Winick park would be a potential for the initial implementation due to all factors, plus the park's proximity to the underpass at I-25. Could rain barrels be use to also help reduce water?
 - v. A feasibility study is recommended to help with public outreach to ensure the locations are feasible for potential users to also lay a foundation for future growth of a community garden program and community gardens on the east side of I-25 was also brought up, potentially Wellville
 - vi. Follow-up meeting with Parks and Rec Department set for 10/18/24 and Alexis will attend the next PROST meeting

b. WCP Memorial Update

- Should there be a wall, 4 feet high or more, on the back to create a more succinct space and give space for plaques to be added under the flags. Possibly 5 feet wall. Cost has to be incorporated into design changes
 - Plaques for memorializing historical timelines, branches, service members from Wellington
- ii. Flag burying ceremonial place is an amenity that is highly backed for the memorial area
 - Possibly a statue or memorial wall to balance and frame the centralized American Flag. Use of local resources (students, local metal workers, concrete companies to reduce cost)
- iii. The cannon has been noted by members as "not fitting" for the area
- iv. General funding for construction (electrical, concrete, landscape) with funding tiers, which can attach to the other amenities (benches, flags, plaques) within a "level package" rather than just asking for donations for specific amenities
- v. 6 benches by the flags (no-back, ADA benches)
- vi. Much discussion on the increased cost of what the wall will incur
- vii. Mingle on Main Fundraising
 - Community outreach opportunities gain feedback and promote awareness
- viii. Potential for PROST members to look for grant funding depending on scalability of the finalized project
- c. ADA Dock Update
 - i. Grand Opening Discussion
 - Smaller, scaled down "opening" with grand opening possibly next year
 - a. Something to commemorate the accomplishments of PROST, local partners
 - b. Potentially on the 16th of Nov.
 - ii. Food Way Elevation Permit all but Stamped

 - Installation for dock





Conceptual Design















