About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the "livability" of Wellington. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 502 residents of the Town of Wellington collected from April 12th, 2023 to May 24th, 2023. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 4% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2023 survey was 18%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Wellington.





How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Wellington's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Wellington residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Wellington's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Wellington's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered after the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your Town's 2023 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within the Town of Wellington were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Wellington was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the Town of Wellington households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the Town of Wellington boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 2,800 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on April 12, 2023 and the survey remained open for 6 weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

The survey was available in English and Spanish. All mailings contained paragraphs in both languages instructing participants on how to complete the survey in their preferred language.

About 2% of the 2,800 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,748 households that received the invitations to participate, 502 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 18%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for the Town of Wellington survey is no greater than plus or minus 4 percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (502 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the Town of Wellington. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a question about whether the respondent lived in Wellington and a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all town residents and became available on May 12th, 2023. The survey remained open for 2 weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2020 Census and 2022 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the Town of Wellington. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python, and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Key Findings

Wellington residents generally feel safe and experience a high quality of life.

Overall, residents gave positive ratings to many measures of the quality of life in Wellington. Nearly three-quarters of residents favorably evaluated Wellington as a place to live, and 8 in 10 were pleased with their neighborhood as a place to live. Wellington as a place to raise children and the overall quality of life in Wellington also received excellent or good ratings from almost two-thirds of respondents. Additionally, a majority of residents reported that they planned to remain in Wellington for the next five years (72%) and would recommend living in Wellington to someone who asks (66%).

These relatively strong results for quality-of-life measures are likely correlated with the positive ratings provided for safety topics within Wellington. Over 9 in 10 residents reported feeling very or somewhat safe in their neighborhood during the day and in Wellington's downtown/commercial areas during the day. Over three-quarters also reported feeling safe from violent crime and from fire, flood, or other natural disasters. Many safety-related services received positive marks, including fire services (78% excellent or good), police/sheriff services (70%), and ambulance or emergency medical services (60%). At least half favorably reviewed the town's crime prevention, as well as fire prevention and education. While results in this facet were largely positive, less than one-third of residents evaluated Wellington's emergency preparedness as excellent or good, a result much lower than national benchmarks. Additionally, 84% of residents stated that safety is an important issue for the Wellington community to focus on in the coming two years, indicating a need for continued attention in this area.

The economy and general affordability are priorities for residents.

The overall economic health of Wellington was identified by residents as the second most important area of focus for the Town (89% essential or very important). While about half of Wellington residents rated the local economy as fair, only 25% gave it excellent or good ratings. Economic development within Wellington was also positively evaluated by fewer than one-quarter of residents . The variety of business and service establishments, shopping opportunities, and employment opportunities all received scores that were much lower than the national benchmark. As the Town continues to invest in economic and commercial development initiatives, monitoring these trends over time will help to better understand performance and progress in these areas.

Results also indicated that residents were less optimistic about their own personal economic outlook and the general affordability of resources. The cost of living in Wellington garnered positive evaluations from only 26% of respondents, similar to other communities around the country. The availability of affordable food, affordable quality health care, and affordable quality mental health care received excellent or good ratings from fewer than one-third of respondents. Finally, when asked about what impact the economy would likely have on their family income in the next six months, only 9% anticipated that it would be very or somewhat positive.

Residents value Wellington's natural environment and parks system but support additional investment in recreational opportunities.

When asked about aspects of the community that the Town should focus on in the next two years, three-quarters of residents prioritized the quality of Wellington's natural environment and its parks and recreation system as essential or very important. Nearly 60% of residents were pleased with Town parks and the overall quality of parks and recreation opportunities in Wellington. More than half of the respondents gave favorable ratings to Wellington's air quality and cleanliness; however, only 44% offered excellent or good reviews to the overall quality of the natural environment, a number much lower than national comparisons. Additionally, around 4 in 10 residents positively evaluated the preservation of natural areas, Wellington's open space, and the availability of paths and walking trails. Recreational services such as fitness opportunities, recreation centers or facilities, and recreation programs or classes all received favorable ratings from less than 40% of residents.

In a series of custom questions unique to Wellington, residents were asked to consider potential recreational offerings. When asked to indicate their level of support for local government investment in various initiatives, a strong majority of residents supported investing in a community recreation center (94% strongly or somewhat support), community gathering spaces (93%), increased trails (91%), open space/community buffers (91%), and a public pool (84%). Residents also stated that their household would be very or somewhat interested in participating in additional outdoor activities sponsored by the Town, like outdoor concerts (90%), nature-based programs (83%), water sports (74%), current sports programs (68%), and new sports programs (62%).

The high rankings of importance for these two facets of livability, as well as residents' support for expanding recreational opportunities, suggest that these areas may warrant the Town's continued focus.

Benchmark Comparisons

While many ratings were below benchmark comparisons, it is important to note that many of the jurisdictions within Polco's national database are larger and/or more established than the Town of Wellington. The best benchmarks are benchmarks against yourself: it will be important to establish and monitor trends for each of these facets of livability over time as Wellington continues to grow and develop.

Facets of livability

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation. The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).

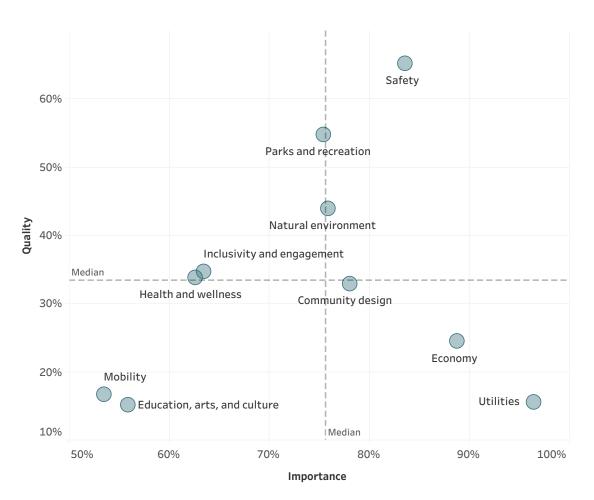
Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide Town staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.

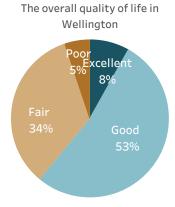
Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 33% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 33% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 76% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 76%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.



Quality of life

Measuring community livability starts with assessing the quality of life of those who live there, and ensuring that the community is attractive, accessible, and welcoming to all.

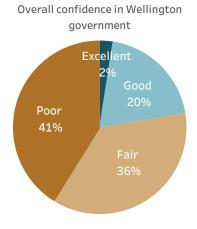

Strong local governments produce results that meet the needs of residents while making the best use of available resources, and are responsive to the present and future needs of the community as a whole.



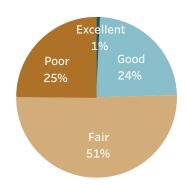

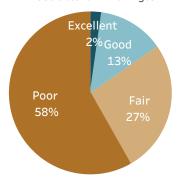

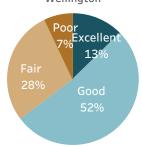

Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™), the Town of Wellington conducted a survey of 2,800 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from April 12th, 2023 to May 24th, 2023. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the Town of Wellington. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all town residents and became available on May 12th, 2023. The survey remained open for 2 weeks and there were 114 responses.

The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2020 Census and 2022 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the Town of Wellington. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.
